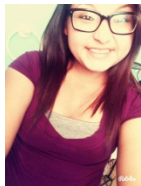

## Enrollment Party

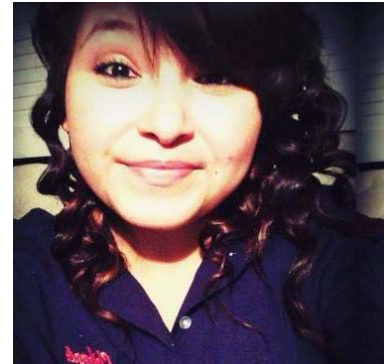
*We will then have our enrollment party on August 30th from 2:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.*
